Uniform Policy

Rationale

The Landsdale Primary School uniform policy has been developed by the Landsdale Primary School Board to promote a positive school culture, foster a sense of community, and create an environment conducive to learning and personal development.

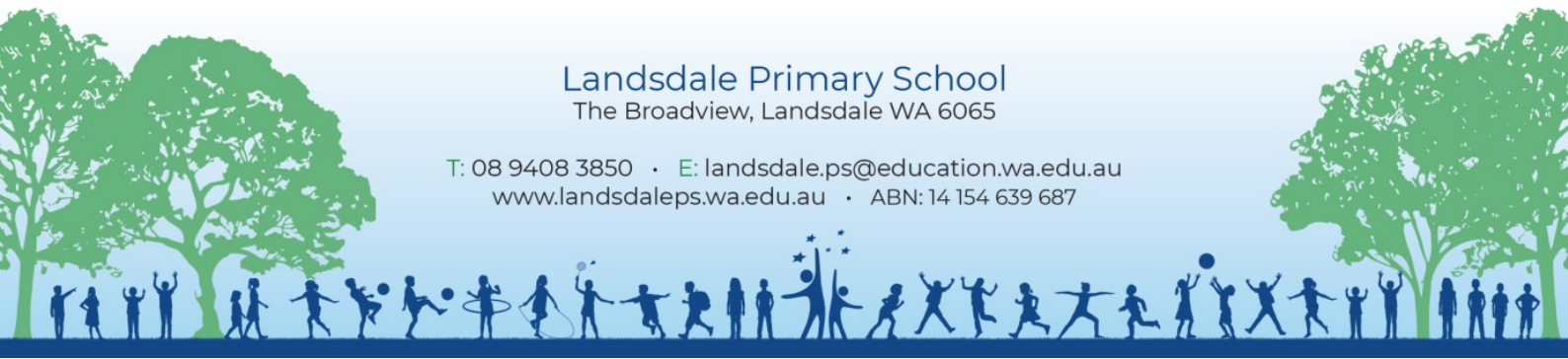
It is expected that all students from K-6 at Landsdale Primary School will wear the school uniform as endorsed by the Landsdale Primary School Board.

The Landsdale Primary School Board believes a uniform policy:

- **Promotes a sense of belonging:** Wearing a uniform fosters a sense of unity and belonging among students. It creates a visual representation of the school community and instils pride in being part of it.
- **Encourages equality:** Uniforms help to create a level playing field among students from diverse socioeconomic backgrounds. Regardless of their financial situation, all students wear the same attire, reducing social comparisons based on clothing.
- **Enhances school safety:** Uniforms make it easier for staff to identify students on or off school grounds and quickly spot anyone who doesn't belong. This enhances security measures and ensures a safer learning environment.
- **Fosters focus on learning:** By removing distractions related to fashion, uniforms allow students to focus more on their learning, enhancing academic performance.
- **Prepares students for future expectations:** Wearing uniforms teaches students about the importance of dressing appropriately for different contexts, preparing them for future workplace dress codes and expectations.
- **Promotes school identity:** Uniforms serve as a visible representation of the school's identity and values. They create a positive image in the community and reinforce the school's reputation.
- **Promotes active participation:** Uniforms ensure that students are safely dressed for specific school activities such as Physical Education.

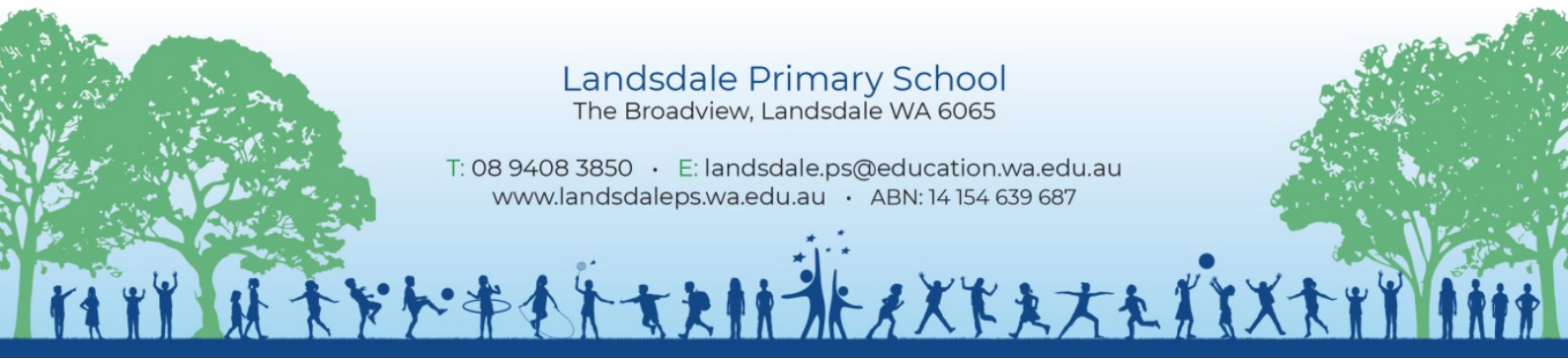
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Uniform Enrolment Procedures

- Parents and students are informed of Landsdale Primary School's Uniform Policy at the time of enrolment.
- Any grounds for exemption will be raised and agreement reached with the principal at this time.
- Acceptance of enrolment at Landsdale Primary School assumes an agreement that the enrolling student will dress within the requirements outlined in the uniform policy, including any negotiated exemptions.
- Families who experience financial difficulties regarding the purchase of a school uniform should contact the school to seek a solution or discuss second hand options.

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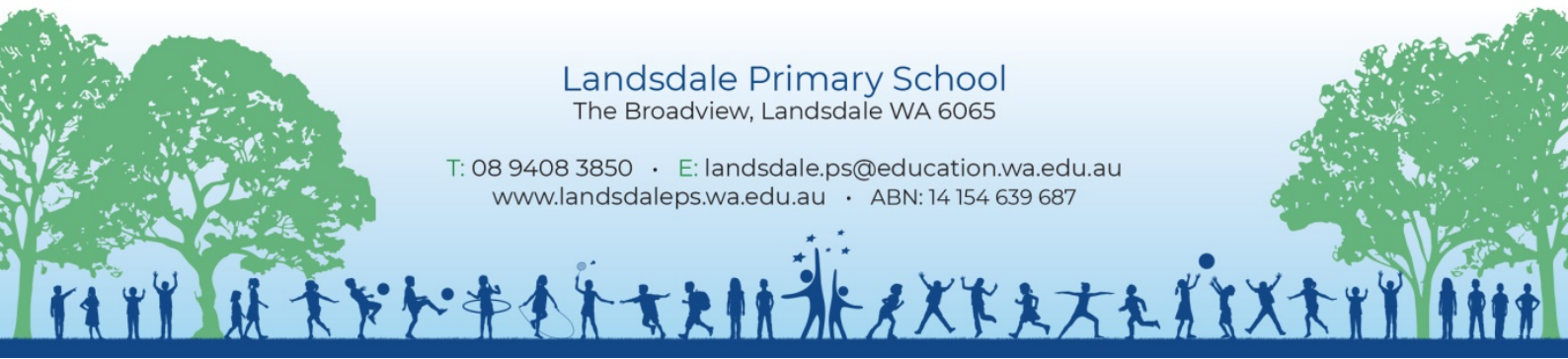


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Uniform Requirements

Item	Expectation	Photo
Shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Landsdale Primary School Polo with school logo. Year 6 'Leavers' Polo Shirt (year 6 only) Students may wear a plain navy blue long sleeve shirt under their school shirt. Faction Polo Shirt with school logo may be worn on sports days. 	
Dress/skort	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Landsdale Primary School Dress with school logo. Navy blue skort (preferably with school logo) 	
Pants/shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Navy blue shorts or tracksuit pants (preferably with school logo). Leggings and bike shorts are not permitted. 	
Jumper/jacket	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Navy blue jumper, fleece zip/weatherproof jacket (preferably with school logo). 	
Hats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A plain navy-blue bucket or wide brim hat (reversible bucket hat with school logo and faction colour preferable). Caps are not permitted. 	
Socks/stockings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plain navy, black or white socks. Plain navy opaque stockings may be worn under skorts. 	



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Item	Expectation
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> It is recommended that enclosed footwear suitable for sport should be worn at all times. Sandals with a secured back strap may be worn during the summer months. Thongs, crocs and sandals without a backstrap are not permitted.
Jewellery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> One pair of studs or sleepers only may be worn. A small digital or analogue wristwatch (smart watches are not permitted and must be handed to the teacher at the start of each day). Some cultural jewellery items may be worn with the approval of the principal.
Accessories & Make-up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Makeup, nail extensions or nail polish is not permitted. Students will be required to remove these items if they wear them to school. UV protection sunglasses are permitted during break times.
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hair should be clean, neat and tidy. Hair longer than collar length must be tied back at all times. Only natural hair colours are permitted.



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Procedures for Not Following the Uniform Policy

Students, and their parents, not following the uniform policy will receive:

- Encouragement from a designated staff member on the benefits of a uniform policy.
- Support in obtaining suitable clothing, if necessary.
- An exemption for an agreed length of time for dress modification.
- A phone call or letter home to parents of students not wearing the appropriate uniform items.
- A meeting with the principal/deputy principal to discuss repeated instances of not following the uniform policy.

Students who have access to uniforms but are not following the uniform policy, may be denied the opportunity to represent their school at official school activities, which includes activities such as; assemblies, excursions, sporting events, social events, choir and camp.

Review of Uniform Policy

The uniform policy will be reviewed by the Landsdale Primary School Board in alignment with our Business Planning Cycle. Parents may have input by contacting any of the members of this committee.

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
