Only a child's first name is used in these publications. Additionally, we utilise secure third-party software to compile student results, which assists us in making informed decisions.

- Student work published or presented in newsletters, competitions, websites and displays.
- Best performance for NAPLAN results and the Australian Council for Educational Research for reading and mathematics test results.
