

Guidelines for Student Mobile Phones

In line with the Department of Education's 'Student Mobile Phones in Public Schools Policy,' which states that student use of mobile phones is only allowed for medical reasons or teacher-directed educational purposes, Landsdale Primary School has established the following rules and expectations:

If a student brings a mobile phone to school, they must hand it over, turned off, to their classroom teacher, who will store it in a locked cupboard. The student can collect the phone from the teacher at the end of the school day.

Students found with a mobile phone on their person or in their bag during school hours will be required to hand the phone into the front office, and a parent will need to collect it at the end of the day.

Mobile phone use is not permitted before or after school, on school grounds, except for brief calls to a parent who may be late for pick-up. If students need to contact a parent, they must do so through the front office. Additionally, students are expected to refrain from using mobile phones at "kiss and drive" to ensure they are fully focused on being picked up.
